Call for Papers: International Conference "Utopia and the New World"

The objective of the international conference Utopia and the New World is to bring together specialists from various academic disciplines dealing with the problematic of modern utopias in Americas and Europe. The concept of utopia has had from its origin a special relationship with the geographical exploration of the globe and with the American scenery. Within this analytical background, we invite you to explore multiple problems, ranging from the transformations of thought, economy and society in the Modern and Contemporary Age, to the formation of identities, migrations, the definition of "Europe" and "America", its birth and constitution.

The proposal should contain the title of the paper, a brief summary (max 200 words), a short CV (containing name and surname, academic affiliation, email, lines of research and recent publications, max 200 words equally). The organization will answer on the acceptance of the proposals before June 21.
