


TEMA+ European Territories — Heritage and Development is a two-year (120 ECTS) bilingual (in English and French) joint master's degree with a possibility to get a prestigious scholarship Erasmus Mundus Joint Master Degree (EMJMD).

At the Faculty of Arts, Charles University, the programme is conducted by the Department of General History.

The application deadline is 23 February 2020.

TEMA+ is a study programme focused on the issues of cultural heritage (cooperation with UNESCO) and the development of a society that is related to it. It is a unique programme operating on the boundaries of multiple disciplines such as history, archaeology, sociology, ethnology, anthropology, museology, urban studies, and architecture. TEMA+ puts emphasis on research and practice.

The programme is coordinated by Eötvös Loránd University in Budapest (ELTE) and the student mobility is divided between this and four other partner universities: École des Hautes en Sciences Sociales in Paris (EHESS), Università degli Studi di Catania (UNICT), Faculty of Arts, Charles University (CUNI), and Université Laval in Québec (UL).
