The two-year MA programme in East European Studies at the universities of Munich and Regensburg will welcome its twentieth cohort in the winter semester of 2023/24. **Applications are accepted until 15 June 2023.**

The Elite Graduate Programme in East European Studies is a **degree programme offered jointly by the universities of Munich (LMU) and Regensburg (UR)**. It is directed at excellent students with a first degree (usually BA), fluency in German and basic knowledge of at least one East European language.

The programme's goal is to convey interdisciplinary knowledge of East, East-Central and Southeastern Europe. In addition, valuable transferable skills are taught in a project course, a summer school in East Europe, an obligatory work placement related to East Europe, and through optional, exclusive soft skill seminars of the Elite Network of Bavaria. **You can find further information about the programme on this website.**

Universidade Federal Fluminense, Brazil – the *Minor in Global Challenges* with a focus on the topic of inequalities.
